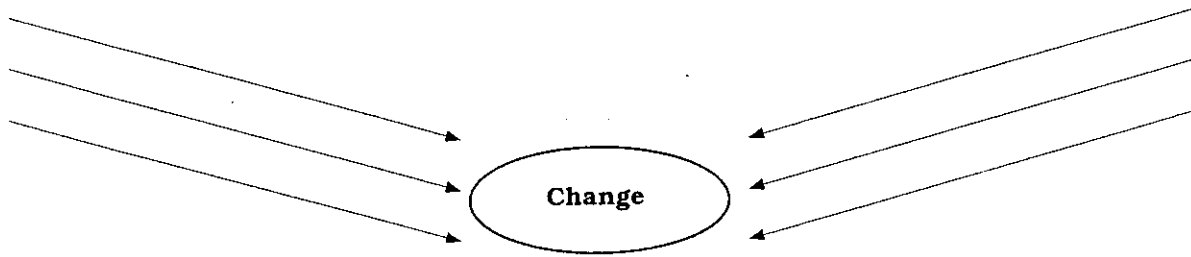


## "A Change Is Gonna Come"
